Liberal "Truths"....

 "We hold these truths to be sadd a underiable : Self-evident , that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed."



What is the role of the Liberal State?

- Liberals want limited state power, but that's not the whole story.
- Liberal states are not weak states
 - Liberal principles make the state strong
 - Liberal states must have the resources to protect Rights
 - Human rights and civil rights are only meaningful if they can be enforced.
 - Only a powerful state can defend the weak against the strong and protect minorities.
- Statelessness means rightlessness

And the role of the Economy

- Liberals are not socialists
- They are tolerant of economic inequality
- Wealth is not a social evil
- Liberals believe in economic competition and individual merit as the basis for success.
- Consistent with a commitment to freedom

The Rise of Right Wing Conservativism

The rise of anti-Liberal public Attitudes

- More openness to Military rule
- Indifference to Russia's meddling in the US Election
- Rising intolerance
 - toward political opponents
 - Rise of White Nationalism
 - Rising Antisemitism
 - Intolerance toward Islam

Breakdown of the Norms of Liberal Democracy

- Breakdown in "The Soft Guardrails of Democracy"
- The Decline of Civic Virtue
 - Presidential pandering to fears and resentments deepens prejudices –Us vs. Them
 - Condoning and inciting violence
 - Violating ethics rules
 - Conflicts of Interest
 - Weakened commitment to truth

Breakdown in a Commitment to Liberal Democratic Institutions among political elites

- North Carolina.....Losers block winner's ability to govern
- Georgia.....closing of polling places
- West Virginia.....impeachment of entire State Supreme Court
- 2016: Unprecedented blocking of a Supreme Court Nominee
- Politicians pandering to fears and resentments, racist sentiments, Condoning and inciting violence

The Very Scary Signs

- The global rise of the illiberal one-party state

 China, Venezuela, Zimbabwe, Russia, Poland, Hungary
- Illiberal parties are part of government coalitions and/or enjoy wide support
- The Rise of Authoritarian Governments
 Poland
 - Hungary

A rise in "fascist tactics" on the part of national leaders (Jason Stanley)

- Promotion of an "us vs. them" mentality
- Nostalgia for a mythic past
- Propagation of conspiracy theories
- Obsession with the "corruption of traditional values" while creating kleptocracies
