U.S. Liberal Hypocrisy

- US Human Rights Abuses
- Myth that the US fights only the enemies of Liberalism
- Overthrow of Governments and support of violent illiberal forces
- Subversion of democratic elections



The weaknesses of liberalism

- The focus on <u>reason</u> leaves out <u>emotion</u>
- Liberal Focus on <u>rationality</u> leaves out <u>heroism (are we really rational?)</u>
- The classical focus on <u>freedom</u> and equality leaves out the human need for <u>security</u>
- The focus on individual freedom, individual rights, and individual equality leave out community solidarity
- The <u>focus on the individual</u> leaves out the <u>need to belong</u> to something bigger than themselves
- The Liberal focus on <u>competitiveness</u> leaves out <u>cooperation and</u> <u>community</u>
- Liberal freedom and equality → insecurity, fragmented community, loss of identity

Why Globalization increases inequality in the United States? High level symbolic analysts account for 10 per cent of U.S. jobs

- Services are in global demand
- So their standard of living has risen
- They are part of a global, not a national labor market
- Services are scarce
- More productivity redounds to their benefit
- The job is to CUT COSTS, increase profits, push up share price...
- And they want to live in the United States

The Routine Production Worker



Once Well Paid but now But now no longer competitive...



Routine Personal Service Workers







The rich get richer and the poor get (relatively) poorer

- Wages have risen for routine production workers and Routine Personal Service workers
- But symbolic Analysists hold the real wealth
- And it comes from their investment portfolios, not salaries.
- And Only about half of American households have any exposure to the stock market,
- ownership of the shares of individual companies is clustered among upper-income families.
